Jacob – Genesis 29.1-30

OPTIONAL/REVIEW:

On Sunday we continued our series in the life of Jacob in Genesis 29.

- If people from your group were there ask them and have them share:
 - What was the main take away for you from Sunday's sermon?
 - What's going to/has changed for you this week as a result?

STUDY:

For the last few weeks we've deviate away from the sermon series and began digging into the "big picture plan of God"

1. So far we've dealt with 2 baseline questions: WHO IS GOD? And WHO IS MAN?

- As a group refresh your memory on what the main answers to these 2 questions are.

Today we will dig into answering the question: WHO IS JESUS?

2. As a group read Hebrews 1.1-4, and 8-12

3. From the passage,

- Discuss what characteristics of Jesus are brought out here.
 - What does each one mean?
- Discuss why any one of these are important/relevant to YOU.

4. Now read as a group Philippians 2.5-11, and Revelation 19.11-16

- How are God's holiness, justice, and love illustrated in these passages?
- There's a reference to "every knee being bowed" here (either in this life or the next).

- If you've done that already what is that caused you to get there?

- If you haven't talk about whats holding you back.

- From these passages – describe in your own words how Jesus' death on the cross and resurrection:

- a) Exemplifies God's love

- b) is a sufficient payment for your sin

- c) restores our righteous standing before a Holy God

5. Prayer:

- Spend some time together THANKING GOD for as many things that come to your mind as a result of who he is and what he's done for us through Christ.
