 - explain your answer.
 - In what ways does this speak to God's Word's relevance today?
5. On a scale from 1-14, how comfortable are you with the idea that the Bible is 100% true and completely and entirely the Word of God. Explain your answer.
 - Does it matter if it is or isn't? why or why not?
 - Is there anything that has or could shake your confidence in the Bible's reliability?
 - At the end of the day, you've either got to place your faith in the fact that the bible is true, or place your faith in the fact that its not...
 - Which one is easier for you? Why?
6. In your own words – describe what it looks like for God's Word to function as a light in a dark place today.
 - What makes living like this hard?
7. Read Psalm 119.9-24 as a group.
 - What do you notice about the writer's attitude toward God's Word?
 - What can we learn from someone like him about the role God's Word can play in our life each day?
8. Pray for one another.
