1. Check in Question: go around and say the top 3 things you love about summer time.
2. We had a baptism on Sunday! On a scale from 1-7 how important does baptism seem to you?
 - In your own words talk about your understanding of baptism.
 - Have you/would you ever get baptized? Why or why not?
3. Review Genesis 11.27-12.9 and the main ideas of the message together:
 - What do you remember?
 - What stood out to you?
4. What do you think people mean when they say "I feel called to do something" today?
5. Talk about any difference you see between God calling someone to do something, and God's sovereign will over everything in the world.
 - Whats the difference and does it matter?
6. Do you think that most people take the call on a Christian's life to holiness and making disciples seriously today?
 - Do you?
 - what makes it hard?
7. We talked about how COST and UNANSWERED QUESTIONS can require great faith to obey a call from God on your life.
 - What is faith? (in anything?)
 - How does faith help us obey?
8. Read Hebrews 11.8-16 as a group.
 - What observations did you make?
 - What new information did you learn about this phase of his life?
 - What more does this show us about the nature of faith?
 - In what ways do our lives today parallel his example of faith?
9. Have you ever felt a specific call from God on your life? Talk about that.
 - What are a few ways to act in obedience this week to a call on your life?
 - How can the group pray for and help you with that?
