

August 21st, 2016 Message Discussion Questions

1. Check in Question: one of your top 5 favorite movies or tv shows.
2. Review the main ideas of the message together:
 - What do you remember?
 - What stood out to you?
 - Read 2 Peter 3.1-10
3. Peter begins by talking about the importance of “wholesome thinking” – how does he see that happening?
4. What does it look like to live the way he talks about in *our* day and age?
5. What do modern day “scoffers” (v3) look like?
6. Read Jude 17-25 together.
 - What did you observe?
 - How does this parallel passage help us to know how to deal with “scoffers” today?
7. We covered on Sunday the 3 good reminders of why Christ REALLY WILL return in vv5-10. What reality about his return stands out the most to you? Why?
8. Why do you think its so hard to keep his return in perspective as we live out each day?
9. Read 2 Corinthians 5.1-10 (Micheal referenced v7 near the end of the message Sunday).
 - What’s happening in these verses? Whats the main idea?
 - How does this help us to keep good perspective about the time we spend on this earth?
 - * What does it look like today to live by “faith” (unseen) and not by “sight” (what you can see and experience)?
10. Read ahead through 2 Peter 3.11-18.
 - What observations did you make?
 - What does this tell us about God? About us?
 - How does this tie themes together from the book as a whole?
11. Pray for one another before you go.
