1. Check in question:
 - Go around and share the coolest thing you've ever built/fixed or put together.
2. Review Genesis 9.18-11.9 and the main ideas of the message together.
 - What do you remember?
 - What stood out to you?
3. Re-read 11.1-9 together as a group.
 - We referenced the connection between pride and disobedience here in vv1-4. Give your own personal definition of pride.
 - Is all disobedience intentional? Why or why not?
4. In what ways do we commonly build our own "Babels" today (either as society/culture, or individually)?
5. Read Proverbs 16.1-9 together as a group.
 - What observations did you make?
 - What does this tell us about God?
 - What does it tell us about humankind?
 - What kind of life does this encourage us to live as Christ-followers?
 - What more information do we get about pride?
6. Read Psalm 2.1-6 together as a group.
 - What observations did you make here?
 - What perspective does this give us on the greatness of God against those who conspire against him?
7. (big messy question) What does it look like for a Christian to live well within today's political climate given the truth of this passage and all of Scripture?
8. What are some of your biggest "plans?" Where do you have the strongest desire to be "noticed?"
 - How can the group pray for you this week as you seek to line your plans up with God's will for you in Scripture?
